***Homework:*** You must follow the directions, complete the homework assignment and turn the assignment in on time to receive full credit. If your homework assignment is handed in late, points will be deducted from the grade. Homework for each chapter of study ***will not be accepted for credit*** after the test for the chapter has been given.

***Late Assignments:***

Late work will be accepted up until the date when a final assessment is given for that concept. Points will be deducted for late assignments..
