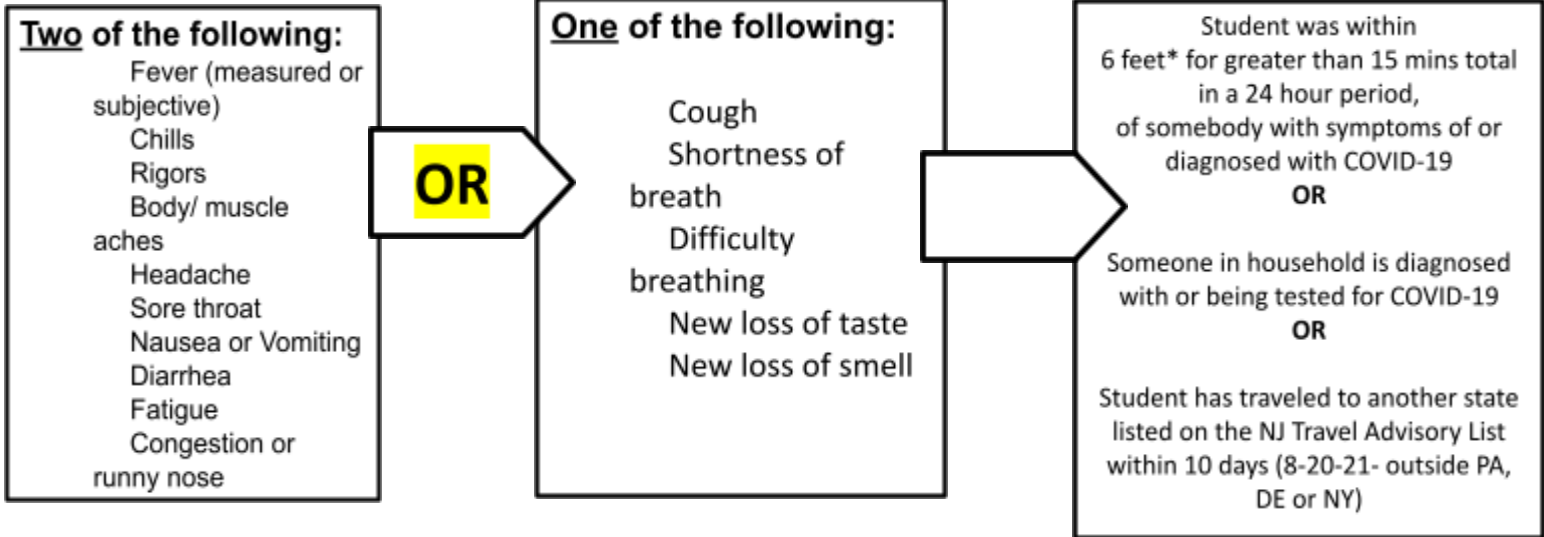




Send Home and Stay Home Guidelines During COVID-19

Individuals sent home are referred to a healthcare provider for evaluation on whether testing is needed.

Students will be sent home to isolate/ quarantine if any of the following criteria are met:



*8/20/21: "In the K–12 indoor classroom setting, the close contact definition excludes students who were within 3 to 6 feet of an infected student (laboratory-confirmed or a clinically compatible illness) where both the infected student and the exposed student(s) correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time. This exception does not apply to teachers, staff, or other adults in the indoor classroom setting." (NJDOH)

COVID-19 Return to School Guidelines

Positive COVID Test

May return after 10 days
AND

No fever for 24 hours without use of medications
AND

Symptoms have improved (ie cough, Shortness of breath)

Negative COVID Test

May return when fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication
AND

Other symptoms improve

COVID-like symptoms; No COVID Test

May return after 10 days
AND

No fever for 24 hours without medication
AND

Symptoms have improved (ie cough, Shortness of Breath)

COVID Exposure

May return after 10 days with no symptoms,
Or

May return after 7 days with no symptoms, and a negative rapid or PCR COVID test on day 5, 6 or 7
